- 1. ** Name of the lottery: Powerball (the Public Lottery conducted under the Bloc Agreement name of "Powerball Lotto Bloc" (referred to in clause 4.3(1)(a) as "Powerball")).
- 2. ** Summary of key aspects of the lottery, including:
 - (i) method by which winning entries will be determined (e.g. draw of balls, type and name of event(s));

In each draw seven balls are drawn from drawing device 'A' containing thirty-five balls numbered 1 to 35 inclusive. The seven numbers drawn are the winning numbers. One ball is then drawn from drawing device 'B' containing twenty balls numbered 1 to 20 inclusive. The one number drawn is the Powerball number.

(ii) number of balls or event 'winners' that determine the odds of winning and winning entries for the first prize and subsequent division prizes;

A player's selection of seven numbers only from the numbers 1 to 35 inclusive to match with the winning numbers drawn, plus one number from the numbers 1 to 20 inclusive to match with the Powerball number drawn, constitutes a game. Winning combinations for each of the nine prize divisions in a draw are as follows:

- Division One all seven winning numbers plus the Powerball number in any one game;
- Division Two all seven winning numbers in any one game;
- Division Three any six of the seven winning numbers plus the Powerball number in any one game;
- Division Four any six of the seven winning numbers in any one game;
- Division Five any five of the seven winning numbers plus the Powerball number in any one game;
- Division Six any four of the seven winning numbers plus the Powerball number in any one game;
- Division Seven any five of the seven winning numbers in any one game;
- Division Eight any three of the seven winning numbers plus the Powerball number in any one game;
- Division Nine any two of the seven winning numbers plus the Powerball number in any one game.
- (iii) if the lottery is subject to a Bloc Agreement the names of the other licensees and the jurisdiction in which they are licensed to sell the lottery;

(iv) the prize structure, such as the number of divisions for prizes; and

The prize structure is pari-mutuel with the legislated 'return to player' comprising the prize pool distributed in each respective draw and a reserve prize pool which accumulates and is used to guarantee Division One prizes and/or supplement prizes in any or all divisions from time to time.

Each of the nine prize divisions receives a percentage based allocation from the total prize pool available for distribution in that draw and all winning games in a prize division share equally in the prize pool for that prize division. Rules for jackpotting or rolling down divisional prize pools apply in circumstances for which there are no winning games in a respective prize division in a draw.

(v) day/date and frequency of occurrence of the draw or event that will determine winning entries:

The draw is conducted once weekly, usually on Thursday evenings.

Draw results are available approximately 8:30pm on the night of the draw with minor prize payments and repurchase available the next day. Major prizes in Powerball are Division 1 and Division 2 prizes. Prizes for all Divisions are available to be claimed on the day following the draw other than Division1 prizes which are available to be claimed no earlier than 14 days from the date of draw.
