

**LIQUOR CONTROL REFORM ACT 1998 (“the Act”)  
ENFORCEABLE UNDERTAKING  
Section 133F of the Act**

**1. Description of Princess (the Licensee) and other relevant particulars:**

1.1 Princess was the Applicant for Transfer of the License from Arctic Thunder Pty Ltd being File No: 11591A05G.

1.2 Difficulties had arisen with respect to the Transfer because of legal issues with respect to the conduct of a function at the premises on 13 March 2010. Ultimately, this matter was disposed of on 3 December 2010 whereby Princess pleaded guilty to trading on that occasion [i.e. 13<sup>th</sup> March] without a Liquor Licence and was fined without conviction.

2. The Director has now indicated that despite the matters dealt with at the Magistrates’ Court on 3 December last, he has granted the Licence subject to an Enforceable Undertaking in the following terms:

2.1 The Directors will undertake [at their cost] to complete the course entitled “Licensee Compliance Certificate” delivered by Franklin Scholar at a place and time to be determined but in any event before 31 March 2011 on such other date as may be mutually agreed by the parties

2.2 Princess also undertakes to adhere to the Terms of the subject Licence No:32223450 and generally to conduct itself in a manner consistent with its obligations pursuant to the Act.

3. Application for Inquiry:

The Licensee acknowledges that the Director and other interested parties specified in the Act may make an application to the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal for Inquiry pursuant to s.90(1) of the Act if the Licensee contravenes this undertaking.

4. Further Acknowledgement:

The Licensee acknowledges that:

4.1 Pursuant to s.133G of the Act, the Director will register this Undertaking in the Register of Undertakings on the Department of Justice website and this Undertaking will be available for public inspection.
